ASHE PIN (Political Information Network) REPORT Sept. 2009

The summer has not seen any progress on the reauthorization of the transportation highway bill. The health care and the energy bills have upstaged the transportation bill in Congress. In addition, Chairman Oberstar was on track to have the bill on the floor and approved at the beginning of the summer. However, President Obama and the Senate wants an 18 month extension to March, 2011 on the current transportation bill, SAFE-TEA LU, with the thoughts that the financing of the bill will be a bit more tolerable when the economy is on more stable footing. Chairman Oberstar is bowing to pressure from his caucus in the House to agree to some extension in lieu of letting the current transportation bill expire at the end of September, 2009. Congressman Peter A. DeFazio, Highways and Transit Subcommittee Chairman, introduced a bill last week to have a 3 month extension of SAFE-TEA LU bill. The idea is to keep pressure on Congress to enact a multi-year authorization bill next year, as opposed to 2011. Chairman Oberstar is planning to markup the 3 month extension proposal the week of September 21, 2009.

ASHE urges all of you to contact your Congressional representative and let them know that you support the three month extension proposal and that you do not support the 18 month extension proposal of the six year transportation bill.

On anther note, the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES) national conference was held in Louisville, Kentucky in August, 2009. After much debate among the 50 State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Surveyors representatives concerning the **MODEL LAW**, it was decided that there was enough evidence to re-evaluate the initial recommendation of requiring an additional 30 credit hours of engineering and technical course work beyond the Bachelor of Science degree for professional registration before approving a person to sit for the Professional Engineer's exam. The ASHE PIN will monitor the situation for more developments in the future.


