

### **ASHE PIN Report - September 2014**

On August 1, the \$10.8 billion Highway Trust Fund patch that will fund highway and bridge repairs for the next ten months was signed by President Obama. This eleventh attempt at getting a long-term funding solution of the highway trust fund has once again been diverted until May 2015. The short-term measure is paid for using a budgeting maneuver called pension smoothing, which allows corporations to reduce their contributions to employee retirement plans. By allowing companies to do so, the government can boost tax revenues since companies are no longer eligible for tax deductions. Although the bankruptcy of the Highway Trust Fund has been diverted, President Obama told Congress it "shouldn't pat itself on the back for averting disaster for a few months, kicking the can down the road for a few months, careening from crisis to crisis when it comes to something as basic as our infrastructure" in a recent speech. Senator Boxer has reportedly been working on an alternate bill that would utilize vehicle miles tax when the Highway Trust Fund comes up for passage again in May 2015.

The ASHE 2014 National Conference was held in Bismarck, North Dakota in June. The TRIKO Valley section was represented by Vanessa Fritsch, Caroline Duffy, and Frank O'Hare. The conference had great technical sessions along with numerous entertainment venues, such as Historic Buckstop Junction in Bismarck and the Village of Medora and Theodore Roosevelt National Park, 180 miles west of Bismarck. The TRIKO Valley section would like to congratulate Vanessa Fritsch upon receiving her award as the National Young Member of the Year!





### **ASHE-TRIKO Valley General Membership Meeting Minutes**

### Tuesday, May 20, 2014 - Montgomery Inn

President Loeffler called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 11:45 am.

President Loeffler announced the June 3rd Reds Game. He announced that plenty of tickets are still available. He reminded everyone of the Golf Outing at the Vineyard on June 27th. Four guests were recognized. Matt announced that Joe Smithson will present on Mitchell Avenue Geotechnical Challenges during today's meeting.

Eric Kistner presented the Treasurers report, noting an operating capital of \$24,516.09. Expenses totaling \$4,699.40 included national assessment and website fees. There are currently 170 members including 4 student members. Vanessa Fritsch raised a motion to accept the treasurer's report, seconded by Caroline Duffy. The motion passed.

President Loeffler presented the Secretary's report in Dave Emerick's absence, noting that minutes from the April 18th meeting were posted in the newsletter and are also available on the back table. Eric Beck motioned to accept the minutes, seconded by Joe Vogel. The motion passed.

Caroline Duffy presented the PIN report, noting the passing of Bond Issue 1, The Ohio Public Works Commission bond initiative. Caroline thanked local county engineers for their leadership of the campaign. In spite of the local win, there is little movement of the transportation bill on the national front. Funding is the real issue. Caroline encouraged everyone to contact their local representatives.

Stan Harris presented the Regional Report, stating the region is working to get all the committees up and running and getting the website ready. Mr. Harris also asked for project submittals for the newsletter. They can be submitted any time. The Scanner also needs future articles. See Stan for details.

Brad Ackel presented the golf committee report, stated that date is June 27th at the Vineyard on east side of town. Registration is \$90 per golfer, which includes cart and door prizes. Hole sponsorships are \$125. This is the sole means to fund two scholarships, so please participate. Registration forms are available at door and on the web site.

Eric Beck presented the scholarship report. Four applications had been received. The scholarship committee will meet May 21st to go over applicants.
