2019 CONSTRUCTION PROJECT LIST

March 2019

1. **2019 Road Resurfacing Program:** Budgeted \$1,300,000. Construction to start in June of 2019. Out for bid in April.
2. **2019 Bridge Program (Various Twps):** We are replacing Nine Mile Road Bridge in Union Township. The plans are currently being finalized with project to begin Fall of 2019. The total cost estimate is \$1,000,000.00.
3. **2019 Landslide Program (Various Twps):** We are repairing 3 landslides totaling \$300,000. Geotechnical and design work has been started on most of these slides and public bidding and construction will begin in summer/fall of 2019.

Transportation Improvement District Projects

4. **Clepper Lane Extension:** This project will provide local road network support for future development and interchange work on the South side of SR 32 by reconstructing, widening, and extending 0.95 miles of Clepper Lane from West of Gate Drive to Bach Buxton Road. This project will be out for bid in March. Estimated construction cost is \$7,650,000.
5. **Old SR 74 at Gleneste Withamsville:** This project will provide local road network support for future development and interchange work on the North side of SR 32 by reconstructing and widening 1.09 mile of CR 171 (Old SR 74) from West of Glen Este-Withamsville Road to East of Schoolhouse Road. This project will be out for bid in March. Estimated construction cost is \$12,000,000.
6. **SR 125 @ Woodlands - Amelia:** This project includes a traffic signal at the intersection of Woodlands and SR 125 in the Village of Amelia. Also included is a newly constructed street system as well as improvements to SR 125. This project was out for bid in February and is currently under contract. Estimated construction cost is \$1,835,000.

****All of the above schedules are dependent on property acquisition, funding availability and other factors that may affect construction schedules.**

Highway Plan Information

The six-year Highway Plan (FY 2018-FY 2024) includes \$8.5 billion for more than 1,400 projects such as bridge and pavement improvements, road widening, reconstruction of existing roads and new routes and interchanges. The plan includes \$4.6 billion for mobility and safety projects, \$2.3 billion for bridge and pavement repairs, \$1 billion in federally dedicated programs (such as transit and congestion reduction programs) and \$600 million for federal GARVEE debt service payments. The \$2.68 billion biennium spending plan (FY 2018-FY 2020) authorizes construction efforts to move forward on nearly 400 bridge repairs and replacements across the state, as well as 410 mobility and safety projects.

The 2018 Highway Plan includes nearly \$1 billion for significant bridge and pavement upgrades in the next two years. In all, the six-year plan includes \$2.3 billion for the KYTC "Safety First" approach for bridge and pavement improvements in virtually every county across Kentucky.

In an effort to enhance infrastructure, accommodate traffic demands and improve safety, the Ohio Department of Transportation – District 9 is furthering the development of the Ross-207 Extension project in northern Ross County to construct a two-lane roadway extending S.R. 207 from its terminus at U.S. 23 to S.R. 159, as well as to improve portions of S.R. 159 and S.R. 180.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Ross-207 Extension project (ROS-207-0.00; PID: 93744) calls for the construction of a new, two-lane roadway - S.R. 207 - between U.S. 23 and S.R. 159. To the west, the new route will connect at the terminus with U.S. 23 at the existing interchange, and to the east, the roadway will connect at S.R. 159 between Delano Road and S.R. 180. In addition to addressing other improvements, roundabouts will be constructed at the new route's junction with S.R. 159 and at the junction of S.R. 180 and S.R. 159.

The purpose of the project is to provide system linkage between these routes, as well as provide transportation infrastructure and access to support existing land uses and economic development initiatives. The project will also improve safety for motorists traveling along the S.R. 159/S.R. 180 corridors and at the U.S. 23/S.R. 159 interchange. Funded with local, state and federal monies, construction is estimated to cost \$8 million, and construction is currently scheduled to begin in the spring of 2020.

PROJECT BACKGROUND

The Ross-207 project stems from a local and state effort to address the county's transportation infrastructure needs in relation to ongoing and anticipated growth and development, specifically in and around the city of Chillicothe, first identified in the 1998 Ross County Thoroughfare Plan. Also included in the plan was the construction of Veterans Parkway; the partial interchanges at U.S. 35 and Pleasant Valley; the widening of S.R. 104; and the first S.R. 207 connector to create a segmented bypass around the county's northern corridor. And while construction and upgrades to these facilities have been completed, the Ross-207 Extension is the final component to complete the connectivity of the county's primary two-lane state highway system to U.S. 23 and U.S. 35.

Working with local officials, ODOT began preliminary development of the Ross-207 Extension project in 2011, and by the spring of 2014, a preferred alternative to extend the route from U.S. 23 to the junction of S.R. 159 and S.R. 180 was selected. However, due to subsequent environmental studies that identified an impact to a Category 3 wetland identified as a fen within the project alignment, the project has been redesigned and the alignment moved slightly south to avoid this unique ecological resource. As a result, the new alternative will connect the roadway to S.R. 159 with a roundabout, and a second roundabout will be constructed at the junction of S.R. 159 and S.R. 180 to aid in the movement of traffic and enhance safety.

PROJECT BENEFITS

Aligning with the Ross County Thoroughfare Plan, the Ross-207 Extension serves to address safety concerns, regional connectivity, and current and future development. As increased traffic volumes are anticipated, the new route will improve the area's transportation infrastructure by moving traffic from narrow, rural roads to an improved state highway system. In addition to promoting safety on these routes, upgrades to the intersections with S.R. 159 and S.R. 180 with the construction of roundabouts will address identified safety concerns and sight distance issues at their junctions. The project also serves to leverage the investments in economic development and support ongoing business and industrial growth north of Chillicothe.

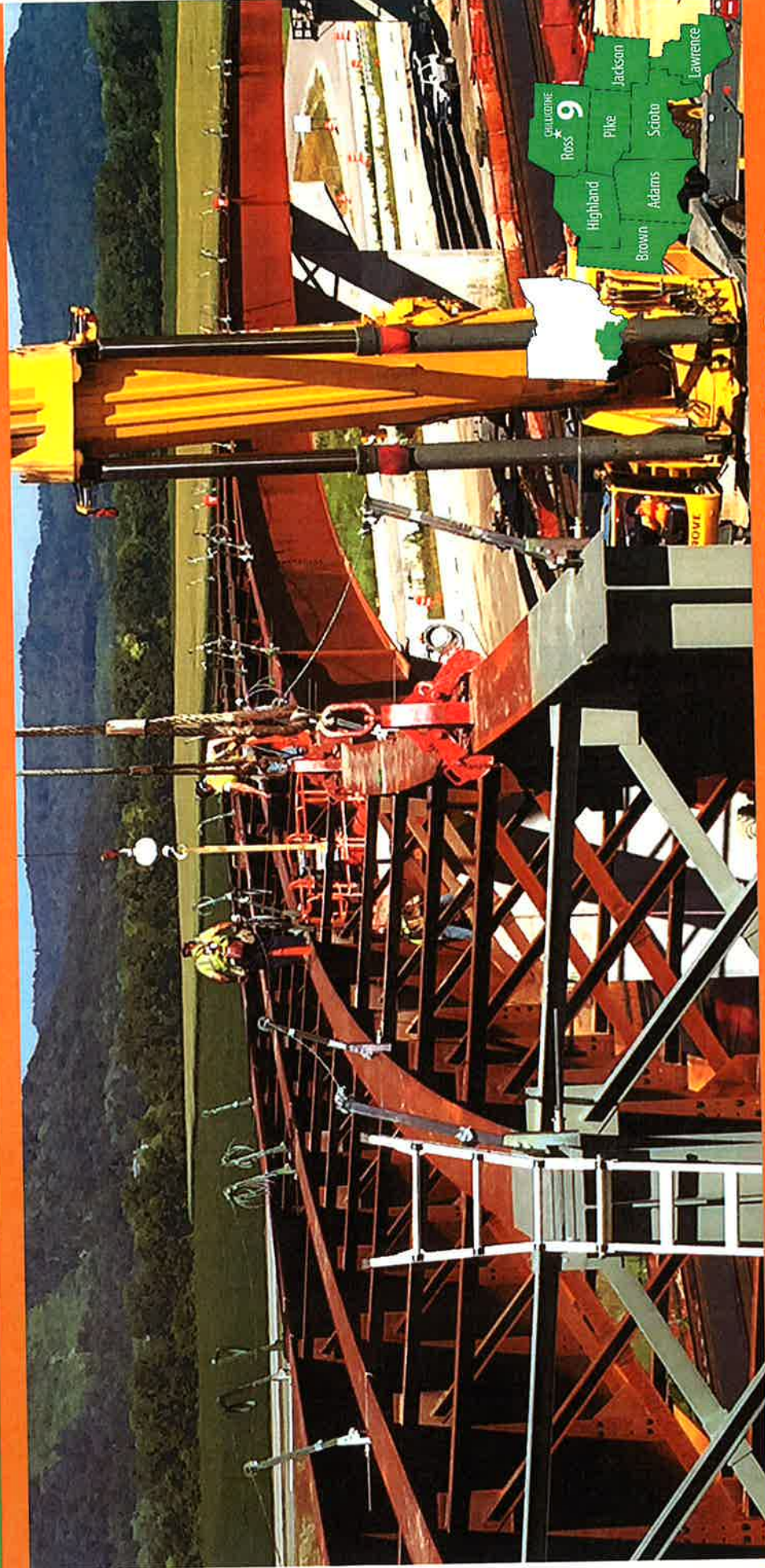
Brown-68/123 Conflict Warning System

- Located in ODOT District 9's Brown County, the intersection of US 68 and SR 123 is an at-grade, rural, two-lane intersection, where US 68 is the major leg and has the free-flow movement of traffic and SR 123 is the minor leg with a two-way stop control. The speed limit on US 68 is posted at 55 MPH, and the road carries approximately 2,050 vehicles per day.
- Over the last three years, there have been a relatively small number of crashes at this location; however, the intersection has a history of angle crashes. A crash study of data for calendar years 2014, 2015 and 2016 found that there were five crashes at this intersection; one of which was a fatal. All of these were angle crashes, and all were the result of motorists' failure to yield from SR 123.
- Both directions on US 68 have dual "Cross Traffic Ahead" and 40 MPH advisory signs followed by dual crossroad intersection and 40 MPH advisory signs closer to the intersection. There are flashing yellow lights at the intersection of this leg. In addition, rumble strips were installed in both directions on US 68 in November of 2003 to give more attention at this intersection and to attempt to slow vehicles as they approached.
- The minor leg (SR 123) has dual oversized 36-inch stop signs and flashing red lights. Following a fatal crash at this location in 2015, rumble strips were installed on the eastbound leg of SR 123, which showed a higher number of crashes. (Rumble strips were not installed on the route's westbound leg due to residences located here.) LED enhanced stop ahead signs were also added on both approaches of SR 123.
- Following research and investigative field studies to improve safety at this intersection, ODOT District 9's Traffic Studies Department initiated a safety project to install a Rural Intersection Conflict Warning System (RICWS). This project will be the first of its kind in the state of Ohio, and it will be constructed during the spring of 2019.
- As part of the project, "Traffic Approaching When Flashing" signs and flashing beacon lights will be installed on SR 123 and "Entering Traffic When Flashing" signs with LED lights will be installed on US 68. These will be activated by loop detectors as traffic approaches the intersection.
