ASHE-TRIKO VALLEY SECTION GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING MINUTES

TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 15, 2022 | THE ORIGINAL MONTGOMERY INN, MONTGOMERY, OH

On November 15, 2022, the ASHE-Triko Valley Section held the fifth general membership meeting of 2022. However, the meeting was not available virtually to membership that could not attend the meeting.

President Katie Dillenburger called the meeting to order at 11:46 am, welcoming attendees, and leading the Pledge of Allegiance. She presented Brian Rhodes with the past president pin and announced that the 2023 ASHE Conference will be held in Atlanta this year from June 7th through 11th. Katie reminded members to go to ASHE Triko Valley's Linkedin page and follow for important information.


Katie asked for a motion to approve the September General Membership Meeting minutes. The motion was raised by Todd Gadbury and seconded by Brian Rhodes.

For the Secretary's report, Dan Springer had nothing to report.

Eric Kistner presented the treasurer's report (see right). Katie then asked for a motion to approve the treasurer's report. The motion was raised by Todd Gadbury and seconded by Steve Mary.

Caroline Duffy presented the PIN report.

Over the last forty years, the midterm elections have typically seen control of Congress turn away from the party of the elected President. While the Democrats had control of both the Congressional houses before this year's midterm election, this year, the Republicans failed to make as many gains as predicted. The actual makeup of the House and Senate have yet to be revealed, as key races remain too close to call in two Senate contests and thirty-three House races as of this writing. It is projected that whichever party is the majority in both the House and Senate will be so by a very narrow margin.



The American Road & Transportation Builders Association reported that voters in 18 states approved 88 percent of the 380 state and local ballot initiatives dedicated to improving infrastructure across the county. To further emphasize that point, all six House Republicans who ran for reelection, after bucking their leadership and voting YES on the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, won their reelection bids on Tuesday.

So what does this mean for our transportation industry? The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law was passed just over a year ago to provide monumental funding to fix our nation's infrastructure. However, each of the next four years will need an accompanying appropriations bill to implement the funding set out in the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law. This passage of the total \$110 billion for roads, bridges, and major projects must be authorized yearly, or the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law has no standing. Please continue to contact your representative, especially the newly elected ones, and become an advocate expert for them to rely on when these authorizations come up. Let's do our part to advocate to the elected officials to keep the funding for our industry on track.

For the Regional Representative report, Brian Rhodes announced that Circle City Chapter in Indiana held its first chapter meeting on October 12th. He also announced that the Detroit, MI area is currently trying to set up an ASHE chapter.

For Triko Valley Membership, Brian Rhodes announced that there was one new member added (Vernon Stultz of KDG) and one guest (Alex McDole of LJB) at the meeting.

Brian Rhodes announced that has begun planning the 2023 golf outing and it will likely be at Glenview, potentially on Thursday, May 11th.

Katie Dillenburger mentioned that the Newsletter went out on November 14th.

For the Student Chapter report, Shawn Mason announced that he will be coordinating with the University of Cincinnati in January 2023.

Steve Mary presented the Program Report and mentioned Schramm award projects will be presented at the January meeting. In March, we are going to do a combined meeting with the Ohio Contractors Association again but this year, we will be joining their evening dinner meeting instead of our traditional lunch meeting. It is tentatively scheduled for Tuesday, March 14th. We will confirm the details and send out more information. Steve also asked the membership for any ideas about a future meeting that would involve a project tour.

Katie Dillenburger presented the Scholarship report on Terry Dull's behalf. Scholarship recipients were announced in the newsletter. Congratulations to Ryan Shoab and Lucia Egula. We will be accepting applications for next year soon. More information is to come.

Katie Dillenburger presented the Social Events report on Terry Dull's behalf. Our Holiday party is scheduled for Friday, December 9th, from 4 pm to 7 pm at deSha's. We are doing a combined event with WTS and ACEC and we will be running a canned food drive. Registration online is open.

GOLF OUTING






